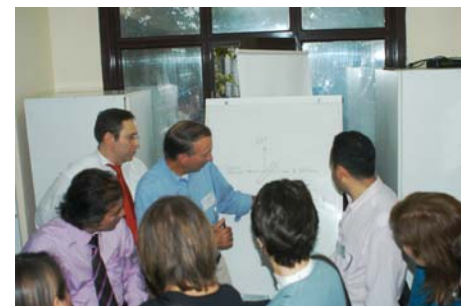
ABSTRACT

The 1st Turkish-US Cytometry Workshop was sponsored by the Turkish Society of Immunology and the Department of Immunology and DETAE at Istanbul University in Istanbul, Turkey on October 24-28, 2007.

The workshop had three faculty podium lecture sessions given in the mornings followed by wet lab sessions on four instruments in the laboratories in the afternoons. On some days, special tutorial sessions were presented by faculty members to a select group of students.

Fifty eight students were registered for the course. Most of the students were from Turkey and five students were from the neighboring countries of Bulgaria, Dubai and Iran.

The faculty was from the USA, Canada, the UK and Turkey. Three of the faculty were supported by a travel award from UICC under their ICRET program. Two other faculty members got travel awards from International Society of Analytical Society and the Clinical Cytometry Society.
